The fixture stands on three intricate scrolled feet, characteristic of the Rococo style popular in France during the 1700s. The wrought iron material, known for its durability and malleability, allowed artisans to create detailed and ornate designs. The turned stem is topped with a single light with new wiring, and dressed with a metal bobèche. The floor lamp is further equipped with an on and off foot switch for easy use. The Louis XV style fixture is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich rusty patinated finish; the aged patina and elegant curves highlight its historical significance, making it a valuable piece for collectors and enthusiasts of antique French decor.
