Forged in France circa 1770, and originated from a grand architectural structure, such as a staircase or balcony, this stunning antique wrought iron railing features a symmetrical arrangement of ornate scroll work, geometric patterns, and classical motifs, all skillfully forged in iron. The elegant central medallion showcases an urn adorned with floral elements, framed by swirling circular patterns that add depth and visual interest. Floral and foliate motifs extend throughout the design, enhancing its timeless appeal. The vertical balusters are accented with decorative finials and linear details, creating a balanced and harmonious composition. The surface is dressed with a thick grey stone slab top, providing a smooth, polished surface that contrasts beautifully with the dark, weathered iron below. The important and heavy console is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich green/brown painted finish with gilt accents; the patina, achieved through age and exposure, adds character and authenticity, making it a coveted addition to any collection of antique architectural elements. Versatile, the elegant Parisian console could serve as a statement piece in an interior design project or be repurposed as a console or divider, blending function with artistry; it could also be used in a hallway, on a outside patio underneath a large big screen TV or even be used as a bar!
