This beautiful antique family bible, titled "Glorious Gospel Blessed God" was printed in England circa 1870. The bible shows the title page of a book titled "Brown's Self-Interpreting Family Bible," which contains both the Old and New Testaments. The book was authored by Rev. John Brown, who was the Minister of the Gospel at Haddington. This particular edition was published by N. Berry and Company in Nottingham. The title page also mentions that this edition includes numerous colored illustrations in oil, along with many additional references and a life of the author. This type of Bible was quite popular in the 19th century, known for its extensive commentary and explanatory notes, which made it a staple in many Christian households. The mention of "colored illustrations in oil" suggests that it might be a more luxurious or special edition, which could add to its value as a collectible item. The Holy book flaunts an engraved brown leather and gilt covering, and is embellished with two brass locks and embossed brass edges.
