Crafted in France circa 1870, and over 6.5 feet tall, the large mirror features an arched top with cut corners, decorated at the pediment with a hand carved crest cartouche of leaf motif in high relief, and flanked with foliage and floral decor on both sides; the frame is further embellished with geometric motifs throughout. The massive frame is dressed with the original beveled mercury glass and wooden backing. The large Louis XVI mirror is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich gold leaf finish.
