Crafted in France circa 1920 in the matter of Michael Thonet, and built of bentwood, the baby chair stands on four curved legs; it features a double rounded ladder back dressed with top finials and a circular cane seat under open armrests. The chair is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich walnut patina.
