Manufactured by Magaud de Charf in Marseilles, France circa 1870, the wrought iron safe is decorated with nail head motifs on all four sides and has an all-original, working mechanism. The front door is further decorated with two large hinges on the sides and a center bronze plaque, and dressed with four decorative brass medallions. The inside opens to reveal an amazing lock mechanism and a large storage compartment. When opened, the inside reveals a top shelf and a fold up shelf with underneath storage; the safe is further embellished with a burgundy red paint interior. The heavy hobnail studded safe is in excellent working condition commensurate with age and use, and adorns a rich patinated painted finish, black on the outside, rouge on the inside.
