Created in Paris, France, circa 1870, each impressive vase sits on a square bronze base with cut corners decorated with leaves and grapes. Each urn is dressed with vine and grape form handles over a body featuring a hand painted medallion with a mother and her child. The removable lid is embellished with a woman bust finial and two cherubs lying among foliage motifs. The large vessels are stamped on the inside with the Sevres motifs for further authentication.
