Created in Paris, France, circa 1880, each colorful vase sits on a round gilt base decorated with acanthus leaf motifs over the feet. Each urn is embellished with hand painted medallions, gilt scrolling borders and have a signature Sèvres green background. Both vases feature a landscape scene with romantic courting couples. The stately, colorful vessels are further embellished with Rococo style ormolu foliate handles and mounts and embellished with a removable lid decorated with a bronze cone shape finial. The large vessels are signed inside each lid for further authentication. The decorative urns are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorn rich colors with gold leaf accents.
