The necks and rims feature detailed geometric patterns in soft pinks and blues, accentuating the overall ornate appearance. The tall vases are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use. The vases could be placed on either side of a console or on a mantel. Red seal characters on the underfoot for further authentication. One vase is slightly taller than the other by half an inch.
