The low table surfaces are dressed with an inset smoked mirrored glass top. Both midcentury tables are in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, and adorn a rich patinated gilt finish. Since 1860, The Maison Baguès has been located in the center of Paris and specializes in the creation of luxury furniture and lighting.
